don't bring it to Florence! Live and breathe the architecture and ambience of your destination. Yes, an Indian touch is important and beautiful, but do not insist on things like jasmine strands and marigolds in Europe!"

For a Rajasthani wedding, for example, Sajad Meherally insists that the experience should include kabla dancers, camel safaris—and dal kachoris. After all, food is another great way to incorporate the destination into the wedding. In Thailand, create a live street food market during the mehndi; serve meals on banana leaves at a Kerala wedding. If you have some guests who eat only Indian food, organise a small section for this; don't impose it on all your guests. There's nothing worse than flying all the way to a new place to feel like there was nothing different or special about it.

7 MAKE IT ABOUT BOTH OF YOU, BUT ALSO ABOUT THEM

The lovely thing about a destination wedding is that it gives you the opportunity to create a truly unique and memorable experience for those who are closest to you. Use it. If you met your significant other at a salsa class, hire a band that can throw a few Latin numbers into the mix and let your first dance be upbeat and soulful. If you share a love of sports, organise an afternoon of volleyball (if you're by the beach) or archery or elephant polo (if you're at a palace venue). Ask your planner and hotel concierge for advice on truly local, authentic experiences you can arrange for guests.

Personalisation can also extend to elements like invitations (movie poster-style for those who love films; lace ribbons for a wedding in France), monogrammed welcome kits, tableware and favours. You can even incorporate your wedding logo on guests' hotel room keys, umbrellas, luggage tags, postcards, and arrival signs at the airport. But remember that personalisation is less about having your initials stamped everywhere you can fit them, and more about being punctual at your ceremonies so you can spend as much quality time as possible with your guests.

8 SWITCH OFF

Enjoy it. Don't sweat the small stuff. Your marriage will have bumps in the road—so will your wedding.

9 SAY GOODBYE WITH FLAIR

Yes, you'll be exhausted, but make it a point to say goodbye to your guests personally, and to thank them for making the effort to be there for your special day. Handwritten thank-you notes will go later, of course, but you should be on hand to bid



farewell. Have a hospitality desk that looks after arrivals and departures (also event transport, event information and personal tours). Provide for guests who have erratic check-in and check-out schedules so that they are not left stranded. The wedding is not over until the last guest has safely left the destination. Leave wedding favours in their rooms so they have time to pack them. Stay an extra night to relax before you leave for your honeymoon, or you might be too tired to truly enjoy it!

10 AVOID THESE TRAPS

Top three mistakes couples make at destination weddings:

Not accounting for hidden costs: Courier charges for your fancy, supersized invitations; corkage; taxes; ticket changes; setup and breakdown fees; extra staff for live stations or sit-down service, etc. Make sure you stick to your budget.

Not letting the pros do their jobs: You hired wedding planners for a reason—let them do their jobs. Trust them. Provide input and oversee, but don't micro-manage—and make sure your families don't either.

Not paying attention to the actual ceremony: If you're using a priest, ensure he's briefed on the couple, the expected duration of the ceremony, whether or not you'll want the ceremony translated. This is the actual big moment, so give it its due. **7**



Do's

- Make sure whoever is organizing the day is clear about the schedule, activities, and how much each girl should contribute towards the venue.
- Write it about the bride's upcoming wedding as much as partying.
- Do discuss with your bridesmaids, any concerns you have about the bachelorette party.
- Think carefully about the guest list and make sure that you get invites who you are excited to celebrate with.
- Take lots of photos throughout the bachelorette party and send it to the girls as a thank you for the party and give it to the bride to look through while getting ready for the big day!

Don'ts

- Just plan on partying, if that's all the bride wants to do that day, but it's sure to split your time for the bachelorette party between a more relaxing activity and a party-heavy activity.
- Don't feel obligated to create a every session on the wedding great list. The bachelorette party should be a fun in itself event giving you the chance to spend quality time with just your closest friends.
- Don't automatically put all of the plans to your next best friend. Be sure to check with the bride and other guests before deciding, especially if the celebration got costly. The bride may also want to respect their car ride as to not by keeping the plans private.

VOGUE INDIA



FOR A SURPRISE PACKAGE
NEHA SETH ARORA

It was a seven-year hitch, of sorts. After seven years of planning events for the Hyatt Hotels in Mumbai, Neha Seth Arora realised she wanted to do more. When she co-founded Var Vadhu two years ago, her 30-slide presentations found a new audience—young mums, sisters of mothers-to-be and fathers. The company has grown rapidly. Arora and three partners have a 65-member team in Mumbai, with 15 others working in Delhi, and a branch in Dubai slated to launch soon. The firm handles baby showers, birth announcements, book readings for kids, birthday parties, weddings and more.

Arora thinks of her reading sessions as kitty parties for young adults. "We get together at one of the kids' homes, bring in good food and a storyteller and make a day of it," Arora explains. Her parties are equally fun. When a family of doctors was throwing a baby shower, Arora sent out invitation scrolls rolled in little feeding bottles. "We used tube tuses

to serve jello shots, and had men wear lab coats and women dress like nurses for photos," she adds.

Since most mothers like to make an impression right from the beginning, Arora takes designing invitations very seriously. From using LPs and jerseys to photo frames and balloons, she's given many an event invitation a creative spin. The usual suspects at her parties include MCs, DIY pottery stations, temporary-tattoo counters, caricature artists and magicians. "If the guest list runs over 200, we even stage plays for children," she shares.


Recently, when a seven-year-old totting a Burberry handbag walked into her office, Arora even suggested a Burberry theme. But she's well aware of how easily a birthday celebration can go completely overboard. "Children older than five know exactly which characters they want on their cakes, and mothers give in to all their demands," she observes. "But we need to ensure the mother's concerns are addressed. You don't want her to be freaked out by

what she sees at the venue."

While some budgets go as high as a few lakh rupees, Arora is equally adept at organising smaller, more intimate parties. But no matter how big or small the event, she always tries to pack in a sweet surprise. 

A fortnight ago, London met America in Mumbai, when Chef Sriram Aylur from Quilon, a coastal Indian cuisine restaurant at Taj St Burchingham Gate Suites and Residences London, and chef Sriji Gopinathan of Taj Campion Place, San Francisco, teamed up to present a four-course menu. The star chefs, who have been friends for many years, were cooking in India for the first time in over two decades, since they moved to their respective outposts where they earned their Michelin's Aylur has one and Gopinathan two. The two put up a four-course menu which included a special seafood platter called Fisherman's Catch. It has got shrimp, black cut and scallops. A simple, rich but high on flavours and texture," Aylur tells us, pointing out that the latter is even, as we looked by home cooks. Offering his inputs, Gopinathan says, "The other problem is using a lot of spices. We want to see colour in each dish. But it cinnamon, star anise, or mace — they all have to be used like medicine, in small quantities," he tells us. He adds that one must not shy away from using technology at home either. "Most of us have combination ovens at home. Take time to go through the manual and use it. You will be able to appreciate your meats and vegetables better," he adds. Aylur has a last tip for the young generation of home cooks. "Don't try to do, as we second guess a lot of things. As a beginner, don't shy away from using a recipe, be it from your grandmother or a cookbook, and follow it to the T. And, never assume cooking is easy as it looks on television food shows. That is all gimmicks."
