


# FLOOR PLAN



## POINTS OF INTEREST

### CHILLON CASTLE

5 minutes by car

Located on a rock on the banks of Lake Geneva, Chillon Castle attracts more visitors than any other historic building in Switzerland. The castle was home to the famed Counts of Savoy for nearly 400 years.

### THE NEST NESTLÉ MUSEUM

15 minutes by car

To celebrate its 150th anniversary, international food giant Nestlé opened nest, a museum in the company's Swiss hometown of Vevey. Spanning more than 3,000 square metres (32,300 square feet), the discovery centre will delight children and adults of all ages at the exact location where Henri Nestlé first developed his milk food in 1866.

### CHAPLIN'S WORLD MUSEUM

20 minutes by car

Discover the true story of the man with the bowler hat here at Manoir de Ban in Corsier-sur-Vevey, the former country estate of Charlie Chaplin's family. The preserved manor house is home to a museum about Chaplin's personal life, while the exhibits in the new building offer a look at his lifetime of artistic achievement.

### LAVAUX VINEYARDS

20 minutes by car

Enjoy a breathtaking view of Lake Geneva and the Alps from the heart of Lavaux's famed vineyards. Discover why bon vivants from around the world are drawn to the wine-growing region while taking the scenic drive through the hills between St. Saphorin and Lutry.

### LAUSANNE CITY CENTRE

35 minutes by car

Lausanne, the second-largest city on Lake Geneva, combines the spirit of a dynamic commercial town with the ambiance of a holiday resort. The capital of the canton of Vaud—and the birthplace of the modern Olympics—is also a lively university town, and hosts conventions and conferences of all kinds throughout the year.

### THE OLYMPIC MUSEUM

35 minutes by car

Experience the Olympics first-hand and learn the history of the Games from ancient Greece to today. Outfitted with state-of-the-art computer technology and audiovisual media, the Olympic Museum will immerse you in the spirit of the greatest athletic show on Earth.

### GRUYÈRE CASTLE AND CHEESE FACTORY

40 minutes by car

Amid a rolling green landscape and the peaks of the Fribourg Pre-Alps, you'll find the home of the world-famous Gruyère cheese—and so much more. The picture-perfect medieval town also boasts a castle and three museums, covering everything from the region's 800-year history to Oscar-winning aliens and Buddhist sculptures.

### MAISON CAILLER CHOCOLATE FACTORY

40 minutes by car

This gastronomical adventure takes you on a journey into the brand, history and products of Cailler, Switzerland's oldest chocolate maker. Equal parts sensual and poetic, Maison Cailler is sure to enchant chocolate lovers the world over.

### GLACIER 3000 / LES DIABLERETS / GSTAAD

45 minutes by car

Cable cars, architecture, adventure—visitors to this famed region come face-to-face with the pinnacle of Alpine excellence, with glaciers, downhill skiing, hiking and so much more.

### ROCHERS-DE-NAYE

1 hour by train

No two worlds could contrast more than those at the beginning and the end of the thrilling train ride from lively, sophisticated Montreux to the austere, wind-swept summit of Rochers-de-Naye. A singular panoramic vista awaits intrepid travellers, with a view of the Swiss and French Alps from The Eiger to Mont-Blanc and beyond to Lake Geneva.

### AQUAPARC LE BOUVERET

20 minutes by car

Aquatic fun for the whole family awaits at Aquaparc in Le Bouveret, a picturesque holiday town on the banks of the Rhône. Transport yourself to the Caribbean without leaving Switzerland by exploring the park's grottoes, waterfalls, wave pools and caves, open 365 days a year.
